For the past 15 years, Schenk-Atwood neighborhood residents have seen a continual increase in the air pollution, noise, odors and hazardous materials created by the Madison-Kipp foundry on Atwood and Fair Oaks Avenues. It's a rare day when the noise and metallic, waxy, chlorine odors from this aluminum foundry do not blow into someone's backyard.

Hundreds of complaints have been filed with the Madison Health Department and Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources. Countless hours have been spent by residents contacting government and company officials, attending public hearings, and trying to get Kipp to be a more responsible neighbor. After all the effort and complaints, there have been no improvements. Adding insult to injury, the DNR has recently ignored violations of air pollution laws by Kipp and approved another 61 tons per year of emissions.

It's time to take action. The federal Clean Air Act allows citizens to file lawsuits when our air pollution rules are not enforced. Wisconsin laws allow citizens to challenge DNR permit issuance when it ignores its own rules.

Join your neighbors as we say, "Enough is enough!".

Taking legal action is never inexpensive and nearly \$30,000 will be needed. Some funds will come from grants, but Clean Air Madison needs members and donations to take our cause to the courts.
